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GLADBROOK-REINBECK COMMUNITY SCHOOL DISTRICT PUBLIC MEASURE TY

Shall the Board of Directors of the Gladbrook-Reinbeck Community School District in the Counties of Tama, Marshall, Black Hawk, and Grundy, State of Iowa, be authorized to contract indebtedness and issue General Obligation Bonds in an amount not to exceed \$17,300,000 to provide funds to build, furnish, and equip a classroom addition to the Junior High / High School building, with related remodeling and improvements, and site improvements?

BELLE PLAINE COMMUNITY SCHOOL DISTRICT PUBLIC MEASURE BJ

Shall the Board of Directors of the Belle Plaine Community School District in the Counties of Iowa, Benton, Tama and Poweshiek, State of Iowa, be authorized to contract indebtedness and issue General Obligation Bonds in an amount not to exceed \$7,950,000 to construct, furnish, and equip additions to the elementary building, including a cafeteria, entrance, and storage areas, and to the secondary building, including a gymnasium with a walking track, weightroom, concession area, and related spaces, and parking and site improvements?

UNION COMMUNITY SCHOOL DISTRICT PUBLIC MEASURE BK

Shall the Board of Directors of the Union Community School District in the Counties of Black Hawk, Benton, Buchanan and Tama, State of Iowa, be authorized to contract indebtedness and issue General Obligation Bonds in an amount not to exceed \$18,500,000 to provide funds for safety and security improvements at all school buildings; to improve mechanical and fire alarm systems at the Elementary buildings; to remodel, repair, improve, furnish and equip portions of the High School and Middle School buildings; to construct, furnish, and equip additions to the High School building and improve the site; and to construct, furnish, and equip a bus barn?

EAST MARSHALL COMMUNITY SCHOOL DISTRICT PUBLIC MEASURE OV

Shall the Board of Directors of the East Marshall Community School District in the Counties of Jasper, Marshall, Poweshiek, and Tama, State of Iowa, be authorized to levy annually a tax exceeding Two Dollars and Seventy Cents (\$2.70) per Thousand Dollars (\$1,000), but not exceeding Four Dollars and Five Cents (\$4.05) per Thousand Dollars (\$1,000) of the assessed value of the taxable property within said school corporation to pay the principal of and interest on bonded indebtedness of said school corporation, it being understood that the approval of this public measure shall not limit the source of payment of the bonds and interest, but shall only operate to restrict the amount of bonds which may be issued?

EAST MARSHALL COMMUNITY SCHOOL DISTRICT PUBLIC MEASURE OU

Shall the Board of Directors of the East Marshall Community School District in the Counties of Jasper, Marshall, Poweshiek, and Tama, State of Iowa, be authorized to contract indebtedness and issue General Obligation Bonds in an amount not to exceed \$19,800,000 to provide funds to build, furnish, and equip additions to the elementary building,

including a gymnasium, classrooms, and restrooms, and to the high school building, including classrooms and restrooms, with related remodeling and site improvements; for HVAC improvements at the elementary and high school buildings; and to remodel, repair, furnish, and equip portions of the middle school building, including the gymnasium and district office, with related site improvements?
