



The **Columbia Wildlife Area**, located three miles southeast of Tama, is a remarkable area for wildlife observation, plant identification, and pond fishing. This area provides 160 acres of wildlife habitat, including timber and

prairie areas. Circular trails provide an opportunity to explore the rich diversity of Tama County's flora and fauna.

Wolf Creek Trail in Gladbrook is an easily accessible hiking spot within city limits. This trail connects with the Comet Trail in Grundy County, providing 9 miles of easy, walkable trails.

Tama County is home to over 1,100 acres of public land managed by Tama County Conservation. A wide range of outdoor recreation is possible in Tama County through staff-led events and educational programming, as well as self-led exploration.



Otter Creek Lake & Park is a beautiful area for outdoor recreation. Visitors may enjoy hiking, birdwatching, wildlife observation, hunting & fishing, camping, educational

programming, boating, playgrounds, swimming (beach only), and more! The campground includes electrical sites for over 70 units, tent section with 17 sites, and showerhouse.

The **Tama County Nature Center** is located at beautiful Otter Creek Lake and Park in central Tama County. The 5,600 sq. ft. facility is a popular experiential center serving as the primary location for

environmental education activities of the Conservation Board and provides a top-quality display room to inspire visitors. When not used for educational purposes, the Nature Center is available to rent. For more information, call 641-484-2231.



T.F. Clark's Park near Traer, IA provides a peaceful, picturesque spot for camping, hiking, fishing, and wildlife observation. This park features 5 electrical sites for 10 units and 3

nonelectric camp sites, an open-air shelter with 80 person capacity, playground, picnic tables and BBQ grills. Visitors may also enjoy fishing access to Wolf Creek.

Ike's Range is a public shooting facility, providing an area for sighting in firearms, target practice, and shooting of clay pigeons. A small pond, associated grassland, and small

timber for wildlife habitat are present on site. Any person wishing to use the facility must have received training regarding proper use of the facility (taught by Tama County Conservation Board staff), paid a user fee, and been issued a range use card and gate key prior to using the facility.
