## Board of Supervisors Minutes August 11, 2025

The Tama County Board of Supervisors met at 8:30 a.m. August 11, 2025. Motion by Turner, seconded by Kupka to approve the agenda. Discussion: None. All voted aye. Motion carried.

Motion by Kupka, seconded by Turner to approve the minutes of the August 4<sup>th</sup> regular meeting and August 5<sup>th</sup> special meeting. Discussion: None. All voted aye. Motion carried.

The Board met with Ben Daleske, Tama County Engineer, to get a road projects report. Daleske also informed the Board that interviews had been held for the open motor grader operator position. Motion by Turner, seconded by Kupka to approve moving the board's regular meeting on September 1<sup>st</sup> to Tuesday, September 2<sup>nd</sup> at 8:30 am due to the Labor Day Holiday. Discussion: None. All voted aye. Motion carried.

Discussion: Knebel would like to see Salt Creek Wind Phase 2 spelled out and not abbreviated as SCW 2 in the notice. All voted aye. Motion carried.

Motion by Kupka, seconded by Turner to approve the claims for payment as presented in the amount of \$373,553.78. Discussion: None. All voted aye. Motion carried.

Public Comments: Public comments were heard from Karen Murty. Public comment time closed at 10:21 am.
